



Lambeth Bikehangars are coming to your street

Dear Josephine Avenue Resident,

You may recall the recent survey that we carried out in your neighbourhood regarding the Lambeth Bikehangar scheme. These cycle storage hangars (as shown in the image above) are award winning secure cycle parking units, designed by Lambeth Council and Cyclehoop Ltd with the sole aim of providing a secure place in a convenient location to park bicycles.

Each unit stores 6 bikes and takes up approximately half of the area of a car parking space. One space in the hangar costs £42 per year to rent, with a £25 refundable key deposit. The charge pays for initial set up, registration, key distribution and maintenance of the Bikehanger for the whole year. Lambeth Bikehangars are positioned directly outside of households to give them added security.

The response we had to the recent survey was overwhelmingly positive from your street, and we'd like to thank you if you took the time to respond. We are now looking at installing bike hangars in your neighbourhood based on the outcome of the survey and the feedback given to us by residents. We're planning to install a hangar outside properties 3 and 49 and opposite properties 38 and 56 in your street. The map overleaf confirms where the hangars might be positioned in relation to your address.
